Strongman in the park ☺

Mariusz Pudzianowski, the strongest man in the world will be a special guest of **KOMUNAL PARTNER (Pavilion 3A, Stand 21)**, a company exhibiting at the Municipal Technology Park. Mariusz Pudzianowski will be present at the International Ecological Fair POLEKO on the second day (21 November) from 12 noon.

The 2007 Polish, European and World Champion will give autographs and conduct competitions for the audience. The visitors will have an opportunity to directly compete with the most popular Polish strongman. Pudzianowski will also participate in the presentations of keys to machines purchased by ALKOM (Bucher EuroFant 50 sweeper) and Przedsiębiorstwo Usług Komunalnych i Drogowych Jan Węglowski (CROSS 16S garbage truck) – 1 p.m., the stand of Komunal Partner.

KOMUNAL PARTNER is the only representative of the following companies in Poland: BUCHER-SCHÖRLING (producer of truck-mounted sweepers and airport sweepers), BUCHER-GUYER (producer of compact sweepers and airport sweepers), GILETTA (producer of snow ploughs and spreaders) and ROS ROCA (producer of garbage trucks, cesspit emptiers, water sprinkling tans and cleaners).

Mariusz Pudzianowski has practiced bodybuilding and related sports for a few years. He has trained karate since he was 11 – he has 4th kyu. He has also practiced boxing. Since 1999, he has devoted his time and efforts to a completely new sport – the Strongman Competition. He has obtained virtually all titles in this sport in recent years. He wants to be the only strongman in history to win the title of the strongest man of the world five times.
