

Wireless Internet Access User Agreement

§ 1

1. This User Agreement defines rules governing the use of wireless Internet access via wireless access points (WAPs) meeting the IEEE 802.11 b/g standard (hereinafter Service).
2. The Service is provided by the Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Poznań (hereinafter Company), 60-734 Poznań, ul. Głogowska 14, entered into the National Court Register - District Court Poznań - Nowe Miasto i Wilda in Poznań, Division VIII, National Court Register, KRS 0000202703, and the VAT register - NIP 777-00-00-488, share capital PLN 42,310,200.00.

§ 2

1. The Service is provided to users (hereinafter Users) who have paid the Service fee as stipulated in the Price List.
2. The Service is sold for one computer and one User only. The computer is identified when the User first logs into the Service.
3. In the case when a time-based Service fee has been made, the Service can be used continuously from the first logging in; the User can log out and log in without any restrictions during the time covered by the Service fee.
4. When the Service fee has been paid, Users receive their login and password.
5. Webpages of the Company and the World Trade Center Poznań are available free of charge.

§ 3

1. Prior to Service use, Users must accept this User Agreement. Logging into the network and starting Service use is synonymous with the acceptance of this User Agreement. Any claims made in the case when this User Agreement has not been accepted will not be admitted.
2. Users are not allowed to use the network for the following purposes:
 1. to send and provide content, which is illegal or which is proprietary and not owned by the User;
 2. to send and provide content, which can violate personal rights of any other person;
 3. to send unsolicited advertising content to an unlimited number of users (spam);
 4. to transmit IP packets with a false sender's address;
 5. to attempt to illegally access IT system resources owned by other network users;
 6. to distribute computer viruses and other programs, which may damage computers of other network users;
 7. to overload the band by providing some network services, e.g. WWW, IRC, NNTP and similar servers;
 8. to build permanent subnetworks, as well as provide Internet connection to other network equipment;
 9. to interfere with the operation of the network in any way other than listed above.

3. In the case when Users do not observe the provisions of this User Agreement and when they use the Service for purposes other than stipulated herein, the Company may block access to the wireless network. In such cases Users are not eligible for any compensatory damages, including reimbursement of the Service Fee.
4. Users are solely responsible for the way in which they use the Service, including for the content and messages sent. Users may be prosecuted for any act against the law.
5. Users are solely responsible for any consequences of Service use when their password has been made available to any third person.

§ 4

1. The network is filtered and the Company does not guarantee proper operation of all network Technologies, e.g. some tunnelling solutions (VPN).
2. The Company reserves the right to register network traffic and process personal data of Users only for the purposes of Service provision.
3. The Company is not liable for any technical interruptions in Service provision caused by events beyond the control of the Company when the Service is out of range (e.g. due to unfavourable weather conditions), band capacity has been reduced, operation has been interrupted or there are other difficulties in Service use.
4. The Company is not liable for:
 1. unauthorized use of software or other proprietary content available in the Internet;
 2. damage caused by third party software;
 3. User's activity in the network, including damage caused by Users;
 4. data collected or transmitted by Users;
 5. damage, which User can sustain in connection with Service use, in particular for:
 1. loss of data or destruction of User's software;
 2. disclosure of User's data;
 3. delay in data reception or transmission caused by transmission interruption, incorrect transmission, delays or breaks in access to the network.
5. Claims related to Service use should be made in writing to Trade Fair Technical Service Units or Exhibitors' Attendants.

§ 5

1. This User Agreement is a document approved by the Company, which has the right to change its provisions. Changes become effective when the new User Agreement has been published on Internet pages.
2. Any matters, which have not been provided for in this User Agreement, will be governed by the provisions of the Regulations applicable to participants in trade fair events organized by the Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie sp. z o.o. in Poznań and subsequently by the generally binding provisions of the Polish law.
